We work with public school districts in Hampden County, South Hadley, and Granby to ensure that all youth in need receive a backpack filled with supplies for the school year. Stuff the Truck is our annual food drive event partnering with the Hampden County Sherriff's Office. Taking place throughout Holyoke, we aim to collect nonperishables and some essential items that are often missing from the weekly food deliveries we receive for our pantries.

In Hampden County, over 49,000 people don't have enough to eat. Many families have to make tough choices between buying food and meeting their other basic needs. Our Springfield, Holyoke, and Chicopee Pantries are open to the public weekly, providing food, toiletries, and other items to help our community.

THRIVE FINANCIAL WELLNESS

YEAR-ROUND

Thrive Financial Wellness programming supports individuals and social service organizations in developing strategies for their clients to achieve financial goals through targeted seminars and collaborative learning events. Thrive is about more than dollars and cents. It is about creating knowledge and developing habits of financial wellness.

ND ONBOARD

More than a single event, OnBoard is a programmatic resource designed to support the health and viability of our community's nonprofit leadership – the Board. Hosted by UWPV, OnBoard offers a series of instructional webinars, networking opportunities, and community engagement activities to prepare anyone for Board service. In December a culminating matching event will bring together area non-profits and board service seekers to mix, mingle, and match.
